Elimu Africa is a volunteer-run, non-profit organization that raises money and awards grants to Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) in Tanzania that provide education to disadvantaged students. Grant applications are reviewed and approved by the Elimu Africa board.

Our administrative costs are very low. In 2011, 98% of donations went directly to projects in Africa!

How to Support Elimu Africa

Understand the Issues

- The majority of Tanzanians are small farmers and unfortunately agriculture is the least profitable sector of the economy.
- 33% percent of Tanzanian households are below the basic needs poverty line.
- In Tanzania, school is not free. Key barriers to education are the inability to pay for school expenses and a shortage of both teachers and schools.
- In 2010, only 3.9% of all 19 year-old students reached higher secondary school. Without education, Tanzanian students have little hope for a healthy and successful future.
